This ranking is just one example. Although the order differs slightly, the sushi toppings that appear in the top ranks are almost the same across different sites. The lower-ranked toppings, however, vary depending on the site. Note that medium-fatty tuna (chūtoro) and lean tuna (akami) are grouped together as “tuna.”

Uramaki

The word uramaki comes from Japanese: ura means “inside-out” or “reverse,” and maki means “roll.”

In Japan, we usually don't say “uramaki.” Instead, sushi rolls are often named after their ingredients, such as “Ebi Avocado Roll.”

This term became popular outside Japan to describe rolls with rice on the outside.
