




ライオンの教室と、ねこの教室にある文房具の数が少しずつ違います。互いに、"I have four desks." "I have 5 desks."のように、やりとりをするペアワークです。もっと詳しく、何がどこにいくつあるかを伝える活動もできます。日本の教科書では、前の単元で、時間と曜日を勉強しているので、"What time is it? What day is today?"と尋ねられます。ちなみに11時50分金曜日です。

The Lion classroom and the Cat classroom have slightly different numbers of stationery items. They will pair up and interact by saying things like, "I have four desks." "I have five desks." They can also describe in more detail what is where and how many of each item there are. In the previous unit of the Japanese textbook, they studied time and days, so you can ask questions like, "What time is it?" and "What day is today?" By the way, it is 11:50, and today is Friday.






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
