



Impromptu role play in a café takeout scenario

It is recommended to do it after the calculation practice (worksheet).

① Add prices to the menu (individually)

Set conditions like "Total for 4 food items should be \$20" or "Drinks should have decimal prices" to make it fun and educational. Be sure to set a time limit to keep it focused.

② Review the conversation (whole class)

If the students have already learned this way of conducting the conversation, review the conversation between the barista and the customer using the blackboard. Gradually erase the English to prevent students from reading during role-play. As the lines disappear, they'll start thinking, "What's next?" and practice more naturally.



Long version

Barista: What can I get for you?
 Customer: **A donut and a coffee**, please.
 Barista: **A donut and a coffee**. Anything else?
 Customer: No, that's all. Thank you.
 Barista: That'll be **\$7.50**.
 Customer: (handing over money)
 Here's **10** dollars.
 Barista: Thank you. Here's your change, **\$2.50**.
 Customer: Thank you!

Short version

Customer: **A donut and a coffee**, please.
 Barista: **A donut and a coffee**.
 That'll be **\$7.50**, please.
 Customer: (handing over money)
 Here's **10** dollars.
 Barista: Thank you. Here's your change, **\$2.50**.
 Customer: Thank you.

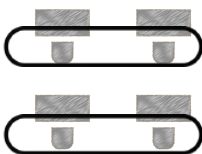
③ Role-play in pairs

Have the conversation with the person next to you, changing the text in red. The barista shows their menu to the customer, and the customer places an order. The customer says, "Here's 10 dollars," adjusting the amount as needed, and pretends to hand over the money.

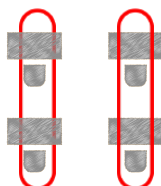


④ Role-play with a new partner

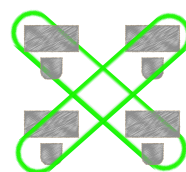
e.g.
