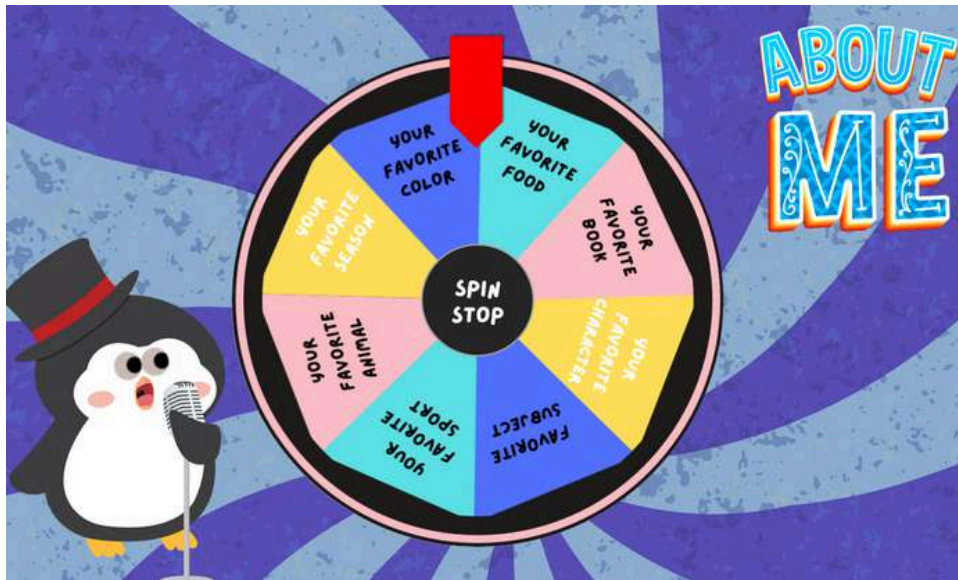


A perfect icebreaker activity!

This warm-up uses a roulette wheel for students to talk about themselves. The topics are simple and easy to talk about, making it great practice for self-introductions and small talk in English.



Whole Class

Students come to the front one by one to speak. They press the Spin & Stop button, talk about the topic, and say their name. The class listens and enjoys together.

Pairs

For pair work, the teacher (or a volunteer) spins the wheel. Students introduce themselves in pairs. They can change partners after each topic or stay with the same person for a few questions. Walking around and making new pairs makes the activity more active and fun!

Groups

Group work is also a great option. Students talk in small groups of 4–5. The teacher (or a volunteer) spins the wheel. When students find something in common, the conversation becomes more fun and natural. It's a friendly activity that even shy students can enjoy!
