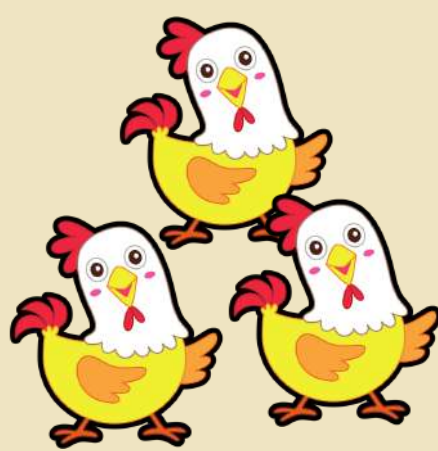

chickens



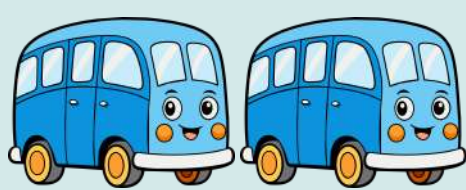

buses

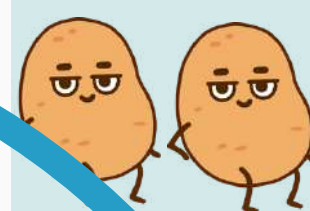

(Nouns end with y; drop y, add -ies)

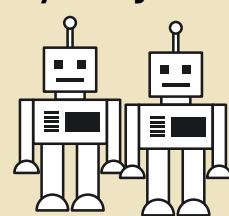


puppy



puppies

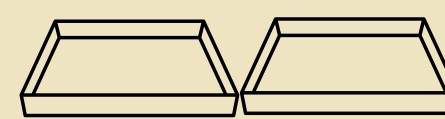
If the letter before "y" is a vowel (a, e, i, o, u), you just add -s to make it plural.
